Our speaker is Professor Peter White from Colby-Sawyer College.

Peter joined the faculty at Colby-Sawyer in 2001 and now holds the Davidow Endowed Chair in the School of Arts and Sciences. He is the Director of Liberal Education and Principal Investigator of a National Science Foundation Scholarship Grant Award that supports STEM education for low-income, academically talented students in biology. Peter received B.S. from University of Massachusetts-Dartmouth and his Ph.D. from Indiana State University. His professional interests include physiology, cell biology, and immunology with a focus on the cellular and molecular events which characterize acute kidney failure.

His lecture will focus on the recent changes in the enrollment and tuition at Colby-Sawyer, the expansion of its nursing program, and his efforts to enhance STEM education for disadvantaged students.
