A Commuting Disaster: The Boston Back Bay Rail Crash

The Back Bay rail crash of December1990 was a headline story. It was the day an Amtrak train collided with an MTBA train sending a flood of injured to Boston's ER facilities. Dr. Mark Friedman, an ER specialist, was hands-on throughout the crises. His talk on February 11 will tell the story from the perspective of the emergency room.

Dr. Friedman is currently chief medical officer of First Step Health and is emergency physician emeritus at St. Vincent Hospital of Bridgeport, CT. He was formerly chief of emergency medicine at St. Elizabeth's Hospital of Boston and assistant professor of Medicine at the Tufts University School of Medicine. Dr. Friedman is a graduate of the University of Chicago's Pritzker School of Medicine, a fellow of the American College of Physicians, and a member of the Country Squires.
