Sept 12, '24 – Mary Kronenwetter – Corbin Park

Mary Kronenwetter is by birth and disposition a New Englander and grew up in a 19th century Massachusetts farmhouse complete with barn and outbuildings, well, and stone wall-lined pasture and fields. She holds a doctorate in educational research, policy, and administration and has held academic administration and teaching positions at colleges in the United States, China, and Japan. Upon returning to New England, she worked as a museum educator at Historic Deerfield, Enfield Shaker Museum, and The John Hay Estate at The Fell. Mary recently published *Pauper Auction*, a historical fiction examining a young woman's struggle to escape unexpected poverty and find autonomy and purpose in early New England. She recently spoke at the Grantham Town Hall about the history of Corbin Park in Grantham; a topic that she will share with the Squires.
