Lunch was followed by our featured speaker, Kim Chandler. Kim spoke on the subject, New Hampshire's Covered Bridges. Kim has written a book on the subject (available on Amazon). There are only 70 Covered Bridges left in NH which once numbered in the hundreds.

Covered Bridges were created to protect the roadway portions of the bridge from the NH weather. They were constructed with a series of trusses to

support the bridges which provided a novel means of supporting the bridges and increasing their lifespan. Unfortunately, the primary reason for the

disappearance of these beautiful structures is arson. The famous Cornish-Windsor bridge is the longest covered wooden bridge. Kim is clearly the expert

on this subject and gave an excellent detailed presentation on the bridges.

The presentation was greatly enjoyed by the assembled members.
